

PRE-APPLICATION CHECKLIST

ELIGIBILITY

1. Do you have an approved charter school petition?

Eligible applicants must have an **approved charter school petition to open, expand or replicate a charter school** from an
Idaho state sanctioned authorizer in order to apply for Federal
CSP dollars under this program. Grant applicants must
conform to the federal definition of a public charter school in
the Elementary and Secondary Education Act to be eligible for
grant funds under the Charter School Program.

2. Are you in good standing with your authorizer?

Defined as Meets or Exceeds Standards in Academics, Operations, and Finance, on Idaho Public Charter School Commission annual report/ State of Idaho Report Card. For more information, see the Idaho Public Charter School Commission Policies page, or contact your authorizer.

3. Are you a virtual charter school?

Virtual charter schools are not eligible to apply for this grant.

Please resolve any of the above eligibility requirements that apply to you to begin an application.
